Suspension lamp in crocodile rattan, handwoven. The name comes from the raw material used, originally called in Kalimantan dialect “Buaya” , then translated as crocodile for its special colour and nuances. The material is neither stained nor lacquered, but provides good weather resistance due to the very fact that it has bark. However, if exposed to direct sunlight, the product tends to discolour quickly. We advise against unprotected outdoor use. Round iron bar frame stained with powder epoxy paint, black colour covered by handwoven crocodile rattan. The material is neither stained nor lacquered, but its peel guarantees a good resistance to weather condition if protected. However, if exposed to the direct sun rays, the product fade quickly. Supplied with complete wiring set. Satin metal upper part for fixing to the ceiling. Max. power 20 W, 220 Volt, bulb holder E 27, bulb not included (electrical cable length 200 cm; steel cable length 200 cm).

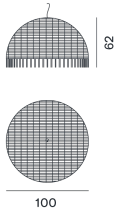

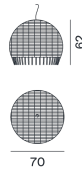
