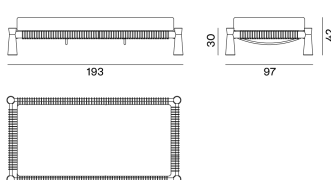

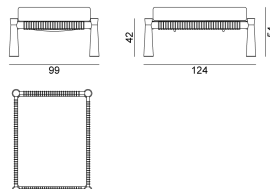
A traditional Indian bed that is low and spacious, the charpoy is reinterpreted by Chiara Andreatti through the use of nautical ropes woven by hand to the structure in Iroko wood treated for outdoor use, characterised by the particular flared design of the legs, on which the seat cushions rest.

Iroko: Iroko wood is a particularly hard species from the forests of tropical Africa. Being a resinous wood, it is naturally protected against water and moisture. It features impressive mechanical qualities, such as resistance to bending. Iroko wood used for this collection is a solid wood stabilized in drying ovens and oiled afterwards. Cleaning instructions: use a soft damp cloth.
